Web-Based Intelligent Tutoring for the Structure Strategy (ITSS)

ITSS is a supplemental web-based program for students in kindergarten to grade 8. It is designed to develop the literacy skills needed to understand factual texts encountered in school and everyday life. The program teaches students how to use text structure to improve understanding and recall. Students use the program twice a week for about 30 minutes per session for up to one year. Students typically use ITSS during class to supplement the English language arts curriculum.

ITSS is likely to increase reading comprehension in grades 4 to 7. The ITSS report is available here.
